Minutes from previous meeting

Subscriptions

Envelopes were delivered to 850 houses and so far £592.50 has been banked. There have been some encouraging comments on the work done by the Association.

Play Area, Shops & Car Park

Brian reported that the Youth Shelter was being repaired by the Parish Council. It was agreed not to replace the burnt football net at this time as it may give the grass time to recover. Dot reports that the PC are getting the slabs inside the junior play area put right and that the ROSPA inspection has been carried out with a few minor things needed to be done.

Garry said that SMBC would be doing a mid week litter pick on Wednesday 16th February. This was a departure from the usual Saturday litter pick that has been well attended in the past. It was agreed to organise a weekend litter pick later in the Spring. Margaret reported that there was quite a lot of litter along Creynolds lane that needed tidying up.

It was reported that the PC is to have a permanent tree of the Christmas Tree type planted on the Village Green that can be illuminated at Christmas time. this was thought to be an excellent idea and better than a temporary one by the shops.

Village Hall

Barry has repaired the leaking radiator in the small hall but as yet no invoice has been submitted. The parish Council have arranged for major work on the heating system to take place on 21st and 22nd February the cost of which is being met by the Parish Council. The Parish Council would like to arrange a number of over 60's Keep Fit class's in the village hall and this was thought to be a good thing for the community and no charge would be made for the use of the hall.

Planning Applications

There has been an amendment of the plans for 194 Creynolds Lane but no details were available.

Magazine & Website

Pat reported that pictures that showed children at the Christmas party could not be used in the Magazine so one showing the party food was used.

Coach Trip and Future Events

The next coach trip will be to Weston s Mare, on 7th May. Tickets priced at £15 per adult and £7 per child. Margaret suggested a possible trip to Southport in September.
